Getting Started with Blending

The first step in blending fragrances is deciding which scents to experiment with. A great place to start is with versatile base notes that mix well with other scents, such as ice pixie and candy floss. However, there are no strict rules—trial and error are key to finding your perfect combination.

One of the easiest ways to test fragrance blends is by using fragrance testing strips. Dip a strip into each of your chosen oils, let them dry for a few seconds, and then hold them together to test the scent combination. Make notes on ratios and results, as keeping track of what works (and what doesn't) will help you refine your blend.

Regulatory Compliance for Your Custom Blend

If you're planning to sell products made with your custom fragrance blend, you'll need to ensure they meet safety regulations. This means obtaining a new SDS (Safety Data Sheet) specific to your blend before creating a compliant CLP label.

At Fizzywhiz, we make this process simple with our fragrance oil blending service, which provides all the necessary documentation:

Skipping these steps and combining two fragrances into a single CLP without an SDS is not compliant and could affect your insurance and ability to sell legally. To sell your own exclusive blends, you must have the correct SDS and CLP documentation.

How to Order

Once you have made your own unique fragrance oil blend you need to email us (info@fizzywhiz.com) the below information and your order number.

Step 1: We need to know the name you want to give your fragrance oil blend. For example, **Fairy Dust**.

Step 2: We need to know the fragrance oil ratio of your blend. You need to use the number and fragrance name on spreadsheet provided.

Example of a Fragrance Oil Blend:

133 - Ice Pixie Fragrance Oil – 50%

170 - Bum Bum Cream Fragrance Oil – 25%

22 - Candy Floss Fragrance Oil – 25%

(Total % must always equal 100%)

Blend Limit – You can combine up to FOUR fragrance oils per blend to equal 100%.

Step 3: We will email you your completed fragrance oil blend official fizzywhiz documentation to the address provided at checkout within 7 working days of purchase.

The Blend Package:

You will receive **emailed copy** of the following Fizzywhiz Official Documentation for your custom fragrance oil blend: In your fragrance oil blend name.

- ✓ **One Safety Data Sheet (100%)** – Specific to your fragrance oil blend.
 - ✓ **One IFRA 51 Certificate** – Detailing usage limits for your fragrance oil blend.
 - ✓ **One Allergen Report** – Listing potential allergens present in your fragrance oil blend.
 - ✓ **One CLP Label (10%)** – For your fragrance oil blend in a non-hazardous base.
 - ✓ **One Safety Data Sheet (10%)** – For your fragrance oil blend in a non-hazardous base.
- These documents ensure your blend is compliant and ready for use in your products.

Additional Documentation:

Each product you create requires its own documentation. If you require additional documentation for your unique blend, it is available at £4.99 per set. This is available in the drop-down menu. You Must add to basket and the same time as the blend package.

Please note that additional documentation must be ordered at the same time as your main package for your unique blend. These documents cannot be purchased separately or at a later date. If you require additional documents at a later date you will need to purchase the blend package first, then any additional documents you want to add. This pays for the admin work on our system to commence.

Terms & Conditions:

Testing Your Blend – It is your responsibility to test your custom blend to ensure it works as intended before use. We recommend testing in small batches before full-scale production to check for compatibility, stability, and scent throw in your chosen application. Fizzywhiz is not responsible for how the blend performs in your products, as every formulation is different.

IFRA Suitability – If your oil is required for a specific application outside of IFRA Category 12, you must check the IFRA certificates for the individual oils in your blend to ensure suitability. No refunds will be issued if the IFRA percentage is too low for your intended use or not suitable.

Turnaround Time – The processing time for this service is up to 7 working days from the date of purchase.

Blend Confidentiality – Your custom fragrance blend is 100% unique and will never be disclosed to anyone else.

Cosmetic Use Notice – If you intend to sell cosmetic products, a CPSR (Cosmetic Product Safety Report) is legally required. An SDS does not grant legal approval to sell cosmetics.
